A few reminders for this term.

Friday Toys – Children can bring in toys on a Friday, please make sure they fit in their school bags.

Breakfast Club - Our breakfast club runs on Mondays to Fridays from 8:00am to 8:45am and breakfast is served up to 8:30am.

After School Club – Our after-school club runs every weekday from Monday to Thursday it is on until 5:30pm and on Fridays it is on until 5:00pm.

PE Kits – Please could all children bring a PE kit for their PE lessons. We tend to go out in all weathers conditions and so PE can be quite muddy therefore it's essential that children bring a change of clothing, especially footwear. If children don't have a change, they won't be able to do the lesson on the field and will have to stay on the yard. Also, a reminder that children can't wear studs for PE for safety reasons.
