Eisteddfod – 9th March

We will be holding our annual Eisteddfod on Monday March 9th at 2pm in the Village Hall. Our Eisteddfod will be in a similar format to last year; it will be led and organised by our Criw Cymraeg (the pupil group who encourage the use of Welsh in our school) and will be a showcase of how we use and learn Welsh in school. It will be an afternoon filled with performance, singing, dancing, reciting, art and cookery.

The Criw Cymraeg have decided the theme for this years Eisteddfod will be Cynefin and Mr Urdd.

Cynefin is a Welsh word meaning 'where we belong', not just their home but anywhere in our lives where we feel a sense of belonging for examples clubs, happy places, nationalities, style, music taste, hobbies etc.

Mr Urdd is the famous mascot of Urdd Gobaith Cymru, the youth organisation to support and encourage young peoples connection with Wales and the Welsh language.

We use our Eisteddfod to celebrate not only Welsh culture but also the talents and skills of our wonderful children! Therefore, the Criw Cymraeg have set some challenges for children to complete at home and bring in for the Eisteddfod. All who bring something along will be given a prize as a reward for their efforts.

Children can create and enter the following items under the theme Cynefin and Mr Urdd, they can create and enter more than one item if they so wish.

2D Art – painting, drawing, photography .

3D Art – sculpture, junk model, clay model, lego.

Writing – handwriting of a Welsh story or poem, an original story or poem based on Cynefin or Mr Urdd.

Cookery – any recipe that is linked to somewhere we belong for example a Welsh recipe, a family recipe or something decorated in something linked to our Cynefin. A piece of cookery inspired by Mr Urdd.

We love to see how different children interpret the themes and they can be as creative as they want.

All are welcome to join us for the Eisteddfod at 2pm, Monday 9th March at Llanfechain Village Hall. There will be refreshments available for a small donation to the school.
